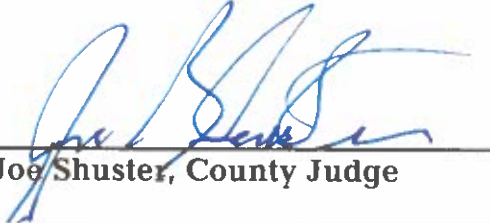


PUBLIC NOTICE

This budget will raise less revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$-1,479, which is a -0.13 percent decrease from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$3,052.
